

## **Public Meeting Video Taping Policy**

Video taping of public meetings held by the Hamilton Township Committee, its boards and commissions shall conform to the following policy that ensures the right of the public to observe their elected and appointed officials while protecting the right to privacy of any members of the public who may feel intimidated by being videotaped. Said policy shall be as follows:

1. A maximum of six private video recorders are permitted.
2. Video recorders are to be without lights.
3. Video recorders are to be placed at the back of the meeting room or the outside ends of the first (front) row, which provides a view of the dais, professionals and staff seated at tables in front of the dais, and those making public comment
